**ORDER ON EMERGENCY MOTION FOR TEMPORARY RESTRAINING ORDER
AND PRELIMINARY INJUNCTION**

THIS CAUSE came before the Court upon Plaintiffs' Emergency Motion for Temporary Restraining Order and Preliminary Injunction (the "Motion") [DE 5], filed herein on January 10, 2017.

By the instant Motion, Plaintiffs move *ex parte* for entry of a temporary restraining order against Defendants to prevent them from closing the FEC Railroad Bridge across the New River Fort Lauderdale Florida for twelve days from February 11 through February 23, 2017. The Court has carefully reviewed the Motion and is otherwise fully advised in the premises.

Accordingly it is hereby **ORDERED AND ADJUDGED** as follows:


(1) A **hearing** is set before this Court in the United States Courthouse located at 299 East Broward Boulevard, Fort Lauderdale, Florida 33301, Courtroom 205F, on **January 27, 2017, at 9:45 a.m.**, at which time the Court will hear argument on Plaintiffs' requested temporary restraining order and preliminary injunction and Defendants and/or any other affected persons may challenge the appropriateness of the relief requested by Plaintiffs and;

(2) Plaintiffs shall serve copies of the Complaint, the Motion for Temporary Restraining Order and Preliminary Injunction, and this Order, on each Defendant by **January 17, 2017**.

(3) Any response or opposition to Plaintiffs' Motion for Temporary Restraining Order and Preliminary Injunction must be filed and served on Plaintiffs' counsel by **January 23, 2017**. Plaintiffs shall file any Reply Memorandum on or before **January 25, 2017**. The above dates may be revised upon stipulation by all parties and approval of this Court. Defendants are hereby on notice that failure to appear at the hearing may result in the imposition of a temporary

restraining order against them pursuant to 15 U.S.C. § 1116(d), Fed. R. Civ. P. 65, The All Writs Act, 28 U.S.C. § 1651(a), and this Court's inherent authority.
